Patriots Join to Form America First Party

On the evening of April 15, 2002, representatives from eight independent state political parties came together to found a new national party.

These founding members of the America First Party were united in belief and purpose. Among them were former Reagan Democrats, conservative Republicans, and refugees from various failed third parties.

Their intention was simple: to restore America to the greatness of the Constitutional Republic bequeathed to us by our forefathers; to re-establish the traditional values of patriotism, honor, family and the right to life; to restore America First principles in immigration, trade and foreign policy; and to restore the

Constitution to its rightful place as supreme law of our land.

With observers present from more than a dozen other states interested in building a new political party, the founding state parties resolved to join together to form the America First Party and elected provisional officers. Five days later representatives of the founding parties met again and adopted provisional rules, a mission statement (see page 2), and founding principles (see page 3) for the new party.

The newly established America First Party quickly created press relations, candidate and party building committees that garnered positive media coverage. In late April, the party's web site went live. Within weeks the FEC had recognized the America First National Committee as a national party committee.

Party headquarters was flooded with requests for more information. The task of building a nationwide party was well underway.

The Founding National Convention was held in Orlando, Florida from August 8 - 11, 2002. This conference finalized the party constitution and platform, and the delegates heard from several of our candidates.

Learning from history and from experience with other parties, the party is structured very simply. The National Committee is granted com-

plete authority over all aspects of the national party. The National Convention is granted primary authority over the platform and the nominations for President and Vice President. An Operating Committee, consisting of the officers and standing committee chairmen elected by the National Committee, exists for the purpose of coordinating the operations of the party in compliance with the resolutions of the National Committee.

The Party also chose to learn from history and experience regarding its electoral strategy. Rather than focus (Continued on Page 7)

Who Are We? Why Are We Here?

Our beloved nation is in big trouble. When you look around, it is plain to see. It was not supposed to be this way. But, our problems can be solved.

Over the past 100 years, we have seen our nation transformed from a Constitutional Republic to a democratic tyranny. We see politicians bending to special interests and taxing us to buy votes. We see our jobs and families destroyed to feed global corporations and the World Trade Organization. We see those rights, granted not by man, but by our Creator, being attacked and undermined by an overreaching federal government. We see the emergence of a global government, elected by nobody, that seeks to usurp our Constitution and turn our sons and daughters into cannon fodder for the New World Order.

We are building this party to take this country back.

As this has happened, the Democrat and Republican parties have merged, both throwing off all semblance of principle and any loyalty to the Constitution or the American people.

These same politicians have continuously attacked our shared values. They have given us an education system that brainwashes our children; a culture handed to us by elites built on beer, bread, and circuses; and an ethic that values selfesteem over self-reliance, and seeks to diminish that which is held dear in traditional American culture -- life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

In short, both the Democrats and the Republicans, who have controlled this country for the past century, either do not care or do not know what is the right thing to do. They have forgotten how to do what is best for America and all the American people. Instead, they prostitute themselves among various special interests, and being re-elected has become their top priority. Over the years, various third parties have arisen to challenge this two-headed beast. Some have had good ideas, and some have not. But in the end they have failed -- captured by either a cult of personality, an ideology that appeals to a very narrow segment of the American people, or internal conflicts that distract from the goal.

In April 2002, after months of careful planning, the America First Party was formed, bringing together activists and grass roots leaders from across the country. It was understood that we needed to do three things.

First, we needed to understand our mission, which is to elect candidates who will adhere to a set of principles based on the wisdom of our nation's Founders. We are not a club. To that end, we adopted the Mission Statement that appears on this page. We also adopted a Statement of Principles, which appears on the next page, and a platform based on those principles. Finally we adopted a set of rules to govern the party that protects and promotes these values. Together, these documents clearly define what it means to put America First.

Second, we needed to hit the ground running with a clear plan for electoral success. In 2002, more than half our candidates got between 15% and 25% of the vote. In 2004, Jeffrey Buck of Massachusetts became the first America First Party member elected to public office.

Third, we needed to make it clear that we are building this party to take this country back. To do that we must unify the tens of millions of folks who agree with us, but are disenfranchised or trapped in ineffective or corrupt political parties. We must also reactivate those who have given up on our system.

If we are going to succeed, we need your help. Please join us. Together we can take our country back. Together we can put America First!

Statement of Principles

Preserve and Protect Our People and Our Sovereignty

- Support a military whose mission is to protect our nation, not police the world
- •Strengthen our borders and promote rational immigration policies
- Protect English as our common language
- •Seek friendship with all nations, but avoid entangling alliances
- •Work to maintain our nation's sovereignty and oppose all attempts to make our nation subservient to the precursors of global government
- Apply American values to our foreign policy

Promote Economic Growth and Independence

- •Restore accountability and Constitutionality to budgets and taxes
- •Promote tax policies that adhere to the Constitution, enhance individual freedom, encourage savings and investment, and promote the family
- •Eliminate unconstitutional portions of the federal government
- •Rebuild our manufacturing base and protect American workers
- Protect our right to fair trade and oppose free trade, exit NAFTA and the WTO
- •Help American businesses stay in America
- Promote a Buy American policy
- •End taxpayer bailouts of corporations and foreign governments
- Implement a self-sufficient energy policy

Encourage the Traditional Values of Faith, Family, and Responsibility

- •Protect and recognize the sanctity of all human life
- Defend the traditional family unit based on one man and one woman
- Promote the primacy of parents in the lives and education of their children
- Respect the free exercise of religion

•Recognize the Judeo-Christian heritage of our shared values

Ensure Equality Before the Law in Protecting Those Rights Granted by the Creator

- Defend the self-evident truth "that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness"
- •Preserve and protect all of the Bill of Rights
- •Oppose all quota systems. Merit and behavior must prevail
- •End judicial tyranny and restore balance to our political system
- •Restore property rights and restrict government land confiscation

Clean Up Our Corrupted Political System

- •Remove the primary source of corruption by sharply reducing the size and scope of the federal government to its limited powers under the Constitution, and return control over all other matters to the states
- •Require that all political donations be promptly disclosed and come from voters
- •Enforce fair, uniform standards for ballot and debate access to give voters more choice
- Implement clean election practices-restore paper ballots
- Reform the lobbying system so that the only organizations permitted to lobby are those organizations whose money is acquired strictly from voter donations. Reasonable individual voter donation amount limits must be established
- •End lavish Congressional pensions--put them on Social Security
- Ban taxpayer funded Congressional campaign mailings
- •Restore the rights of states in the manner of choosing Senators and Representatives and promote the citizen legislator

The Statement of Principles of the America First Party was adopted at the first meeting of the National Committee on April 20, 2002.

The Principles provide an outline for the party's Platform, which contains a section for each of the Principles headings. Each Platform section then expands upon that particular set of principles.

The Statement of Principles is the core statement of beliefs of the America First Party. As such, a two-thirds vote of the National Committee is required to adopt any change to the Principles.

The Party Constitution binds both the National Committee and the National Convention to adopt a platform consistent with the Principles.

All party leaders are required to support and advance the Principles as a condition of holding a position of trust within the America First Party.

A Party Organized for Success!

Many third parties have come and gone, most of them done in by hostile take-overs, internecine fights, or lack of organization and focus.

With this in mind, the founding members of the America First Party planned and carefully implemented a party organization which will protect the investment in time and money made by the members.

The America First Party Constitution operates under a system of federalism at its highest level. It has accomplished this by making the National Committee, with its two elected representatives for every state party, the highest governing authority.

The National Committee also serves as the Credentialing Committee for its own membership, and for the National Convention. This averts the risk of one or a few individuals being in a position to manipulate the makeup of either the National Committee itself, or the Convention. These safeguards, in turn, insure the integrity of the platform and the party's Founding Principles.

The National Committee meets at least monthly, and so is truly in a position to monitor and govern the party.

Officers and committee chairmen are elected by the National Committee and

may be discharged at any time should the National Committee lose confidence or trust in them. Each officer and committee reports directly to the National Committee and is subject to its directives.

Standing Committees are established by the Party Constitution to organize the functions critical to the party's success. Each committee is responsible for developing and carrying out party operations within its assigned area.

National Committee members and rank-and-file party members can join a committee and work in areas of their expertise and interest. The Committee system organizes and focuses the talents of the members.

After the onerous and distracting experiences many of us have experienced in other parties and patriotic organizations, we are excited to be part of a party that will provide a stable platform for political action, and which supports our moral and constitutional values.

In addition to the built-in stability of the new organization, we are an ideologically unified group, strongly united behind our founding principles and the party platform. We are now moving forward to position ourselves for the 2004 elections.

The Committees and Their Duties

Here is a brief description of the duties of the various committees. Each Committee welcomes new members who wish to contribute talents and efforts to the party's business.

Rules Committee - proposes amendments to the Constitution, rules for the conduct of the party, and works with State Parties in development of state party rules.

Platform Committee - develops and proposes platform and policy for adoption by the National Convention.

Party Building Committee - helps build and maintain the party on national and state levels as a major political party.

Finance Committee - develops budgets for party operations, works with the Treasurer,

and advises state parties on fund raising and other financial issues.

Public Relations Committee - creates strategies for interfacing with the media and the public to promote the party.

Candidates Committee - assists the state parties in the recruitment and election of candidates for local, state, and federal office.

Ballot Access Committee - assists the state parties in acquiring statewide ballot access.

Convention Committee - organizes the national convention.

on higher offices like governor, senator, and president, the Party has chosen to focus on races where it can be competitive, and where it has sufficient infrastructure to support successful candidacies. The Party wants to grow candidates like it grows the party, from the grass roots up, and bring national resources to bear on every race.

In 2002 and 2004, that focus is on local and state races, with the occasional congressional candidate. In 2006 and 2008, the party expects to field more congressional and statewide candidates. The America First Party intends to field its first competitive presidential candidate in 2008.

In November 2002, the party faced the electorate for the first time, fielding ten candidates to elective office representing the America First Party throughout the country. Third party candidacies are considered successful if they receive 3% of the vote, and most do not achieve success. The Party's candidates did much better than that. At every level -- city council, state legislature, and congress -- more than half of the candidates earned between 15% and 25% of the vote. Several candidates came within a few votes of winning their races. In March 2004, the Party elected its first public official, winning a local race in Massachusetts.

The Party's media outreach has also been a success. The Party's award winning web site has received almost 4 million hits and the party has been mentioned favorably in many newspaper and magazine articles. Various party leaders have appeared as guests on national and local radio and television programs.

As the fastest growing political party in the country, the America First Party has become the only party that will challenge the duopoly that has taken over this country. The Party offers a populist, truly conservative, alternative that appeals to the many citizens who are looking for a voice that represents their views. The Party appeals both to those who feel disenfranchised and to active voters.

The leaders and members of the America First Party fully intend to be the party chosen to lead this country back to its founding principles. Our struggle is for the heart and soul of this great nation; our goal is the restoration of the Constitutional Republic bought and paid for with the blood of patriots; and the only acceptable conclusion to the struggle is Victory!

The America First Party urges patriots to join with us to accomplish the noble task that is laid before us. Working together, we will put America First once again.

The America First Party regularly circulates media releases about timely issues. Here are summaries for some recent releases:

Bush Immigration Plan Comforts Alien Invaders, Destroys American Jobs (Jan 12, 2004) - party opposes George Bush's planned changes in immigration law which reward illegal aliens who have already invaded our country and broken our laws. Bush Policy on China Rejects Thomas Jefferson, Insults Basic American Values (Dec 12, 2003) - condemnation of recent statements by President Bush against the aspirations for freedom by the people of Taiwan, and his pandering to the butchers and tyrants who rule in Beijing. Massachusetts Court Takes Liberalism to a New Low (Nov 21, 2003) - condemnation of the decision by Massachusetts courts to sanction homosexual marriages.

Moore's Removal Obscene, Pryor's Nomination Repugnant (Nov. 14, 2003) - the decision by the Alabama Court to remove Chief Justice Roy Moore from office is yet another obscene attack on the constitutional rights of every citizen.

Party Calls for Bush Impeachment (*Nov* 4, 2003) - Party adopts a resolution calling for the impeachment and removal from office of President Bush for taking our Nation to war without proper constitutional authority.
